Europe - State of the Union

2017 is the 60 year anniversary of the “Rome Treaty”; - a most important milestone in the development towards the EU defining the communities of the different nations. The millennium generation of political executives down to parish counselors however must ask questions of where they and their administrations have failed and/or damaged the EU over the past decades. Around the year 2000 many European states have seen a change of generation in their political elites. European nations including people in White Russia, Ukraine, the Russian Federation etc. in the future can rise to and achieve the European Idea and its underlying values core to the EU concept. On this basis true EU leaders now and in coming years must concentrate effectively to heal past and current faults felt by the people and develop fresh European cohesion strategies for the next level of EU acceptance and attractiveness.
